

Roscoe PTO Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.

Secretary's Report – Minutes from October meeting were reviewed. Motion to approve minutes by Brett Hruby. Seconded by Rod Stuffle.

Treasurer's Report – Kim Henderson reviewed the current budget. Walk-a-thon made \$13,500, fall pictures were under budget, fall sale projected to make approximately \$10,000. No questions from attendees.

Superintendent's Report – Mrs. Keli Freedlund reported that the district is down about 60 students, which may affect fundraising dollars.

Mrs. Jeanne Zelton, RMS school nurse, discussed the myths about head lice. After increased rumors on Facebook, she explained that lice is always present in schools, more in the younger grades. There is not an outbreak going on in the district. She encouraged parents to check their own children monthly for lice, and demonstrated the correct way to check.
