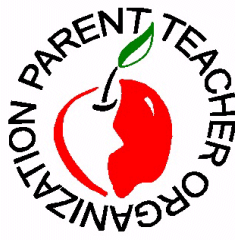

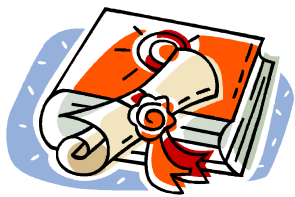


SC / LW Yearbook

Important Info from your Kinnikinnick and Roscoe Middle School Nurses



The State of Illinois has added a new, mandated, vaccine to the required 6th grade physical and dental examination and added vaccine requirements for children currently attending Roscoe Middle School. Effective Fall 2012 all students entering 6th through 12th grades are required to receive 1 Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis) vaccine regardless of the interval since the last DTaP, DT or Td dose. A tetanus shot is not sufficient. A Tdap vaccine, which includes diphtheria and pertussis, is required for all students entering 6th, 7th, 8th and 9th grades. A record of this vaccine/immunization must be on file in the nurses office BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL NEXT YEAR! Make appointments for physicals and vaccines now!! Kinnikinnick, Rockton, Prairie Hill and Hononegah school districts have established the first day of school as the required date to comply with health requirements, called "first day exclusion". This means that if your child does not submit proof of required vaccines or physicals, he/she will not be able to start school.
