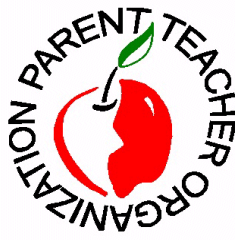

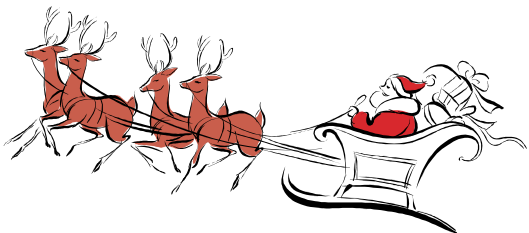
Beef-a-Roo Nights

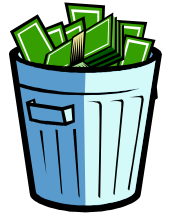


SC / LW Yearbook
