

## **Roscoe PTO Minutes**

The meeting was called to order by Dave Franklin at 7:04 p.m.

### **Introductions**

### **Secretary Report**

- Keli Freedlund delivered information about the state mandate to educate all first through eighth graders about sexual abuse. She explained that staff from the Carrie Lynn Children's Center will be presenting programs to all students at end of February/beginning of March. Keli asked if the PTO would allow them to come to next PTO meeting to explain content and presentation to parents before the students hear them, with the opportunity to ask questions/express concerns. This is strictly a program to teach kids how to deal with abuse, it is not a sex education course. The material is age appropriate. All teachers will hear the material at an inservice prior to the student programs.

- Family Science Night: Rochelle Keener explained that this free night is hosted by the Discovery Center. We are still in need of volunteers. The date is set for Jan. 23, 2014.

- Golfing4the Kids: Dave Franklin reported that planning has started for the golf outing. Pizza Ranch has returned as our Platinum Sponsor for \$3000. There will be a meeting next week to find additional committee members.
