

Roscoe PTO Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm. Board introductions were made.

Secretary's Report – Minutes from March meeting were reviewed. Motion to approve minutes by Brett Hruby. Seconded by Jody Tomilonus.

Treasurer's Report – Kim Henderson reviewed the current budget. At this time the budget hasn't changed much from last month. We should come close to meeting our budget for the year.

Principal's Report – Mr. Chad Etnyre reminded that report cards are going home this week. He thought Culver's Night went well, but not as crowded as McTeacher's Night. He also reminded that the Art Fairs and Music Programs are coming up later in April.

Superintendent's Report – Mrs. Keli Freedlund announced the four new school board members: Tonya White, Amy King, Chelsea Benson, and Terri Hausvich. There is still one seat open. New this year – the District Retirement Open House will be combined with the PTO Gem Awards/Volunteer Appreciation Reception. Lastly, the district met the Illinois 5 Essentials Survey requirements, so we will receive data back soon to use for the school improvement plan. She has recently posted a letter on website listing reductions over the past few years.

Committee Updates

Garage Sale – The sale will be this Saturday at Kinnikinnick from 8am – 3pm, with setup on Friday at 1pm. We have had quite a few donations this year, but we are still looking for volunteers.

Golfing 4 the Kids – Dave Franklin reported that the event is May 18, and registration ends May 3, cost is \$85/golfer. Currently about 60 golfers signed up. Because it is a scramble, the game is good for non-golfers as well. We expect to raise about \$8000 from sponsorships, with other opportunities to raise money on the course. There are lots of great prizes also.

Chocolate Sale – Rochelle Keener reported that most of the chocolate has been distributed. The kickoff is scheduled for 1:50pm Monday at Kinnikinnick. Mr. Schwuchow has agreed to kiss the pig again if we sell all the chocolate.
