# READ-A-THON

January 18th - February 1st

### What:

- This is your PTO's biggest fundraiser of the year! Due to covid restrictions, we will be unable to hold a Fun Run this year, and therefore, have decided to host a **Read-A-Thon**! We are asking for each student to raise a minimum of \$30 to help reach our fundraising goal.
- Students will read (or be read to) age/grade level appropriate books during Jan 18 - Feb 1 for as many minutes possible using a variety of platforms (i.e. epic, raz-kids, paperback/hardcover books, etc).
- Students will keep track of their total minutes on their log sheet, filling in one cricket for every 20 minutes read **outside** of school hours.

### How:

- Students will obtain pledges from family, friends, neighbors, and local businesses. All donations will go straight to Roscoe PTO to support your schools, classrooms, and teachers.
- Remote students/classrooms:
  - Please print off the log and pledge forms at home
  - Log minutes and collect pledges the same as in-person learners
  - Utilize online donation platforms and email your logs to your classroom teacher **or** mail/drop off logs and donations to the school office

- **All log/pledge sheets and donations are due by Friday, February 5th, 2021!**

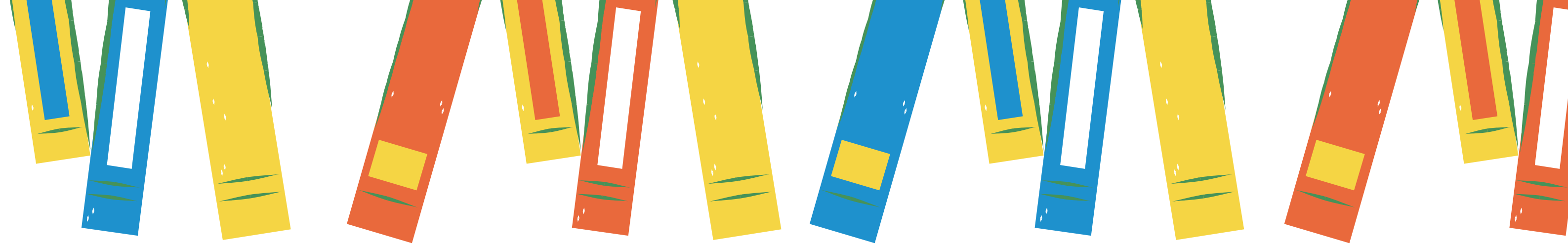
### Awards:
