In order to be considered for this scholarship, you will need to show evidence of prior service through listed activities, a personal essay, and one letter of recommendation. In addition, you must plan to continue to volunteer in the future. We will also give consideration to class GPA and rank, extra-curricular activities, and financial need.

Rules and Regulations for Application:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior who legally resides within the boundaries of the Hononegah School District.
- Applicant must be a graduate of Roscoe Middle School.
- Applicant must enroll in an accredited two-year or four-year program.
- The Roscoe PTO Scholarship Committee will select a recipient based on the criteria given. All personal information will be blacked out before applications will be read by the committee, as to not cause any bias.
- The Roscoe PTO Service Award will be issued in the amount of \$1,000 in the form of a check. A check will be written out directly to the recipient to be used as needed for your education.
